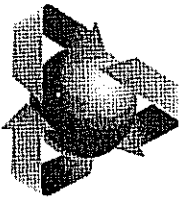

WE MUST SAVE AND RECYCLE THESE ITEMS:

Each swelling unit will be given a "Mahoning Township Recycles," 6 gallon recycling buckets. The following items are mandatory recyclables:

1. Clear glass
2. Green glass
3. Brown glass
4. Aluminum cans

ALL GLASS:



Rinse items, remove and discard caps, and do not break glass.

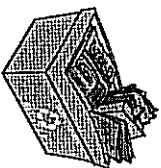
We cannot recycle drinking glasses, mirrors, plate glass or light bulbs.

ALUMINUM/STEEL/TIN CANS: Rinse containers, may crush cans. Aluminum cans can be placed in a recycling bucket or in plastic bags and tied securely. **Please do not include aluminum foil, trays or pie plates.**

Newsprint: Bundle, tie or bag.

Magazines: Bundle, tie or bag.

Recycling buckets available at the Township Building Monday through Friday from 7:00 AM to 3:00 PM.



Plastic No. 1 & 2 Clear and Colored

Bottles:

Rinse, remove lids, separate clear and colored.

Separate 1s from 2s.

PLASTICS NO 1

Include the following: Coke, Cola, 7Up, Pepsi, etc., salad oil, mouthwash, liquor, coffee jars, peanut butter jars, tennis containers, Gatorade, Hi-C, Pine-Sol, dish detergent, Spic & Span

Avoid all of the following bottles: Microwave trays, tub containers, bottles with handles, containers with any pesticide or chemical agent

PLASTICS NO 2

Include all of the following bottles: Clear milk water jugs that have foggy appearance, colored detergent bottles, i.e.: Wisk, Tide, Clorox, Era, etc.

Avoid the following bottles: Any bottles having had motor oil, anti-freeze or any chemical gent in them, and vinyl bottles i.e.: Soft plastic squeeze bottles

Township residents may also take recyclables to JAWS Recycling on Railroad Street in Danville each Thursday & Friday from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Mahoning Township has a mandatory recycling program with curbside collection, done in Zones A and B the second consecutive Thursday

and Friday of each month.

Commercial business establishments situated within Mahoning Township are required to set up their own recycling program and must submit evidence of recycling arrangements and documentation of the tons of material recycled.

New businesses should register with the Township office.

BRUSH/TREE TRIMMING:

Mahoning Township currently has a site available for residents to dispose of brush from tree trimming. Residents may obtain a key to our lower shed at the Municipal Building, on Thursday and Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. only, where they will be asked to sign a paper agreeing to the terms for dumping:

No commercial dumping is allowed, privilege is for residents only.

No branches over eight inches in diameter.

No grass, leaves, thorns, garden waste, or root bulbs are accepted.

Mulch also available from this site.

SPRING CLEANUP/ DUMPSTER DAY:

Mahoning Township holds an annual spring cleanup/dumpster day, which is usually at the end of April.

LEAF COLLECTION:

Leaf collection program for bagged leaves begins in October and continues through November.

CHRISTMAS TREES:

Christmas tree collection begins after Christmas and continues into January. Trees must be free of debris and curbside by 7:00 a.m. DO NOT place trees in plastic tress bags
